

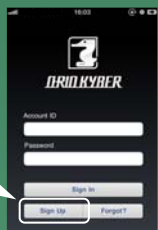
## Get started



Search for "KYBER" in the AppStore or Android Market and download the application to your device. The application is free.



## 2 Create an account



- 1 Tap the "Sign Up" button.
- 2 Enter your account information.
- 3 You'll receive a confirmation e-mail. Click the link to complete your account registration.

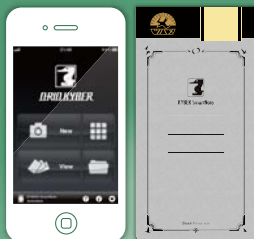
## 3 Activate

<iPhone> <Android>



- 1 <iPhone> Tap the "Activation" button in the bottom left of the main screen.  
<Android> Tap the "Activation" button in the options menu of the main screen.
- 2 Snap the QR code on the first page of the KYBER SmartNote.
- 3 If the activation is successful, digitize tickets will be added to the count displayed in the top right of the camera screen.

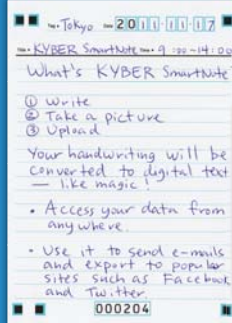

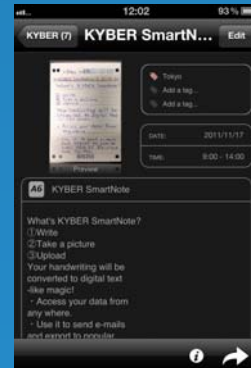
Congratulations!

## Let's try using KYBER SmartNote

### Write and take a picture



After writing on a page, take a picture of it with the KYBER application and upload it.



The handwriting in the uploaded image will be converted to digital text and displayed in the application. From there, you can freely copy and paste the text, edit it, and make corrections.

### New features

### Add tags



Handwriting in the tag area of the note will be digitized and automatically added as a tag in KYBER.

## Use your digitized text

### 1 Select text

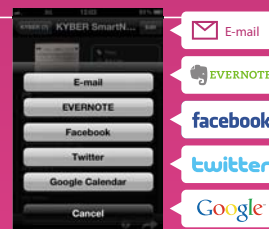
- Double tap or long press to select some digitized text. A menu appears allowing you to do things like:
1. Copy selected text to the clipboard
  2. Google search
  3. Wikipedia search
  4. Google Translate



### 2 Export to other services

#### 1 E-mail digitized text.

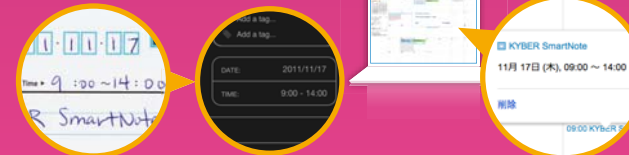
- 2 Export to EVERNOTE, Facebook, Twitter, and Google Calendar after registering your accounts with KYBER.



#### Other account settings

- In the settings screen, select a service under "Export" and register your account credentials.

### Sync to your calendar



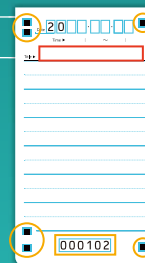
Create an event by writing the time, date, title, and description. Your event will be digitized and you can export it to your Google Calendar.

## Notes

If you don't observe the points in this section, your text might not be digitized correctly.

### 1 About writing

- Don't write in the areas marked by .
- Write times when you want to add an event to your calendar.
- Write the title where the is.
- When writing the date, don't go outside the blue frame.
- The system uses the solid lines to break up the text when digitizing so don't write across the solid lines.



### 2 About taking pictures

- 1 Make sure the four corner marks are in the picture.
- 2 Don't take the picture from too far away.
- 3 Don't take the picture from a skewed angle or where it is too dark.
